## Course Objective

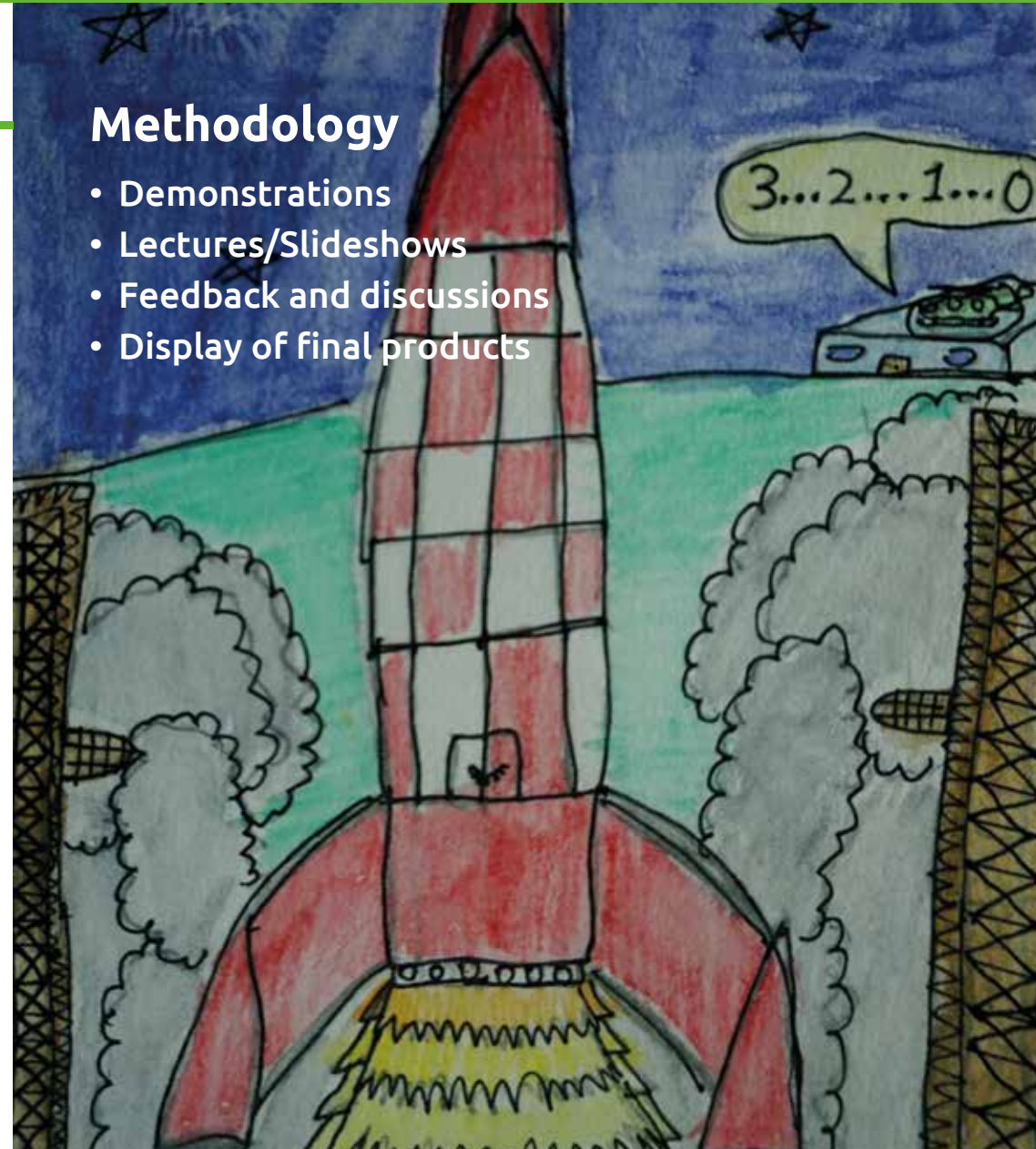

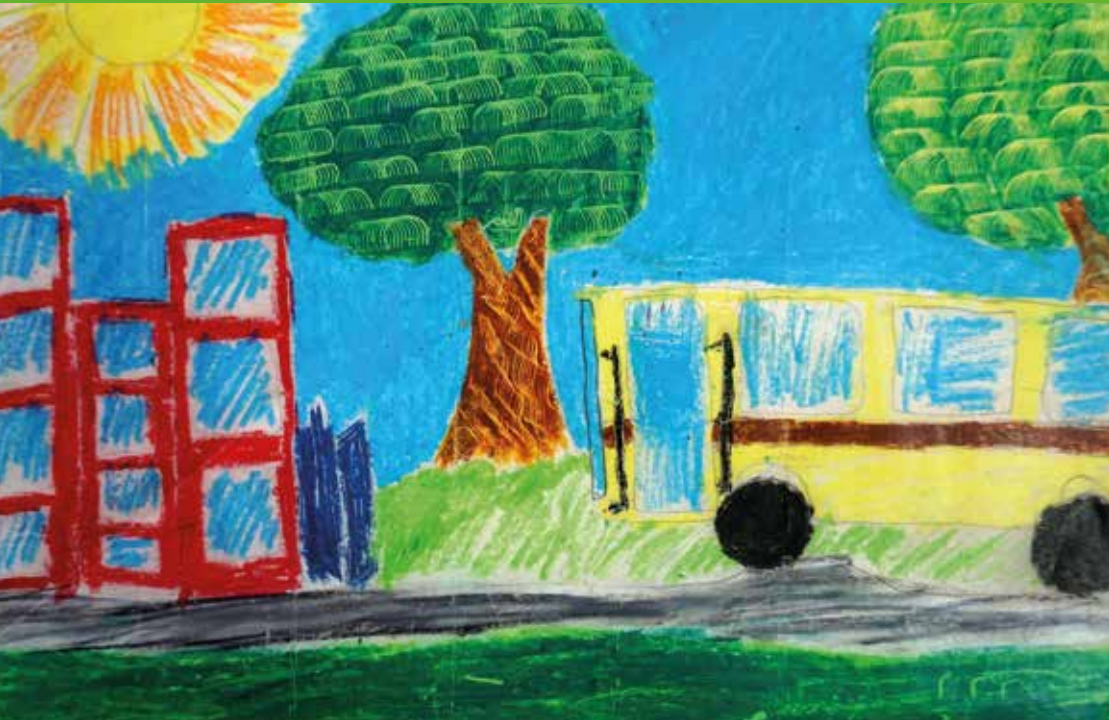
