Introduction

India has a long tradition of oral storytelling. We all have heard stories from our mother/grandmother. We also tell stories and gossip about others. Now it's time to record and broadcast those stories to the world.

In this unique workshop participants shall learn how to tell a story through Sounds and create their own Podcast/Radio Play. You will learn basic of Microphones, Sound Recording, and Design so you can record good Audio even for Videos. Participants shall be challenged against the clock to develop a concept, write a script and performs. Each group takes it in turns to experiment with Audio Equipment's, sound effects, Record, and edit. By end of the workshop, participants will upload your Podcast/Radio Play for rest of the world to listen.

Objective

Objective of this workshop is to introduce the oral story telling practice and basics of Sound Recording/Design. So that participants can learn how to record good sound even on their computers/smart phone and create Podcast/Radio Play and broadcast it online.

- Introduction to Storytelling through Sound; Podcast, Radio Drama, E-book.
- Listen to some of the best Indian/International Podcast/Radio Plays.
- Introduction to Sound Recording and Design, both Professional as well as DIY (with Smartphone/Computers) for beginners.
- How to Make your DIY Recordings Sound Awesome.
- Concept development, script writing and Recording
- Sound Edit, Music Sourcing, Effects and Mixing.
- Create your Podcast Channel online, Upload and Broadcast it to the world!
- Learn how to earn from Podcast!

Hitesh Chaurasia is a faculty in Film and Video Communication in National Institute of Design Ahmedabad. He has been an Academic Council Member of Satyajit Ray Film and Television Institute Kolkata and conducted Sound Recording workshops at prominent institutes like Symbiosis Institute of Design Pune and Sound Ideas Academy Mumbai.

He is a 2003-2006 batch graduate of Satyajit Ray Film and Television Institute Kolkata with around 12 years of Professional experience as Sound Designer/ Filmmaker including 15 feature films, many documentaries, Shorts, TV shows, Commercials, Web, and Radio. He has won multiple awards including V. Shantaram Best Sound award for Marathi Feature film Gajar and was nominated for Best Sound Award for feature film Bhopal A Prayer for Rain.

He has worked for Fox, Warner Brothers, BBC Radio 4, Y Films, National Film Development Corporation (NFDC), Public Service Broadcasting Trust (PSBT), and Tata Institute of Social Science projects.

He is the founder of Dantkathaa Media, which explores possibilities of Sound in different mediums. He has recorded Radio Drama Undercover Mumbai live on location in India for BBC Radio 4 and designed a radio play Krishnaleela for 92.7 BIG FM. He has also done a sound Installation Bombay Beating the Dirt. Hitesh has also Produced & Directed short film Second Best & web series 50 Shades of Love.
