Introduction

Paper is a very sensitive and versatile material and the art of origami is quite old. Etymologically the word Origami comes from the combination of 'Ori' i.e. folding and 'Kami' i.e. paper. The art of paper folding is associated with Japanese culture for over the past 1,000 years. From our childhood, we are exposed to this craft by means of making a paper boat, paper aeroplane, paper birds etc.

Origami is a craft for everyone and very easy to practice at home. The craft is also very much beneficial for cognitive improvement, hand-eye coordination, analytical skills as well as creative ability and mathematical reasoning, to name a few.

Participants will explore and learn the advanced technique of paper folding to create beautiful sculptures or products. A lot of artist and designers have adopted this technique to express their ideas and creative expression. These techniques are also abundantly used in making functional products, garments, toys, and packaging and even in architecture. The workshop aims at the creative exploration using paper as a medium to come up with interesting surfaces and usable products.

Objective

- The main aim of the origami workshop is to explore and learn the advanced technique of paper folding.
- The workshop also provides a platform to explore the properties of paper as a medium through sequential folding for improving sequential thinking capability and creative ability.

Course Content

- Paper as a material: the strengths and drawback of the material
- Techniques of paper folding: Single fold, letter folding, cupboard folding etc
- The relationship between Paper Folding & Geometry

- Three-dimensional tessellation and surface generation using paper fold
- Application of the same technique to generate a beautiful product / sculpture.
- Exhibition / Display
